Summary:

More than 1,000 people were killed in a magnitude 6.8 earthquake that struck near Marrakech, Morocco, late on Friday, September 8. As of around 7pm local time on September 9, state-run media reported 1,305 deaths and 1,832 injuries, the majority of which were reported as critical. The hardest-hit area was Al Haouz Province, where 542 people were reportedly killed. At least 13 deaths were recorded in neighboring Marrakech province, the report said.
